

Corinne Snow is a counsel at Vinson & Elkins LLP. She previously served in several positions at the U.S. Department of Justice including as Counsel and Chief of Staff in the Environment and Natural Resources Division of the U.S. Department of Justice, where she assisted in managing a 600-person division that included 400 lawyers. In this role she helped manage the Division's civil and criminal litigation arising under more than 150 environmental and natural resources laws.
