



Lilian Sotolongo Dorka is the Director of EPA's External Civil Rights Compliance Office (ECRCO), within the Office of General Counsel. ECRCO is responsible for enforcing several federal civil rights laws which, together, prohibit discrimination on the basis of: race, color, or national origin (including on the basis of limited-English proficiency); sex; disability; and age by applicants for and recipients of financial assistance from EPA. ECRCO works diligently to ensure that the protection of human health and the environment is a reality for all persons in the United States, regardless of race, national origin, language ability, disability, sex or age.

Prior to coming to EPA, Lilian worked for the US Department of Education's Office for Civil Rights, where she served most recently as the Senior Counsel to the Assistant Secretary for Civil Rights for over 10 years. Her work included enforcement of civil rights laws to ensure equal educational opportunities for all students.

Lilian has been working in the civil rights enforcement arena for 35 years and considers it her life's work. She received her BA degree in political science/English literature from the University of Miami, Miami FL, and her JD from the Catholic University School of Law, Washington, DC.
