Dr. Sabine Lange is the Chief Toxicologist at the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) and is the Director for the TCEQ Toxicology, Risk Assessment, and Research Division. Dr. Lange's responsibilities include overseeing health effects risk assessments and the development of chemical toxicity factors, and coordinating and conducting research activities. Dr. Lange serves as a technical resource for the State and citizens of Texas for human health and environmental risk assessment, especially related to air and water quality.

Dr. Lange received a Bachelor's degree from the University of Western Ontario in Canada, and completed a Ph.D. and post-doctoral training in biochemistry and molecular carcinogenesis at the University of Texas at Houston and MD Anderson Cancer Center. Dr. Lange is a Diplomate of the American Board of Toxicology.
