

Charles Maguire joined the Oil and Gas Division of the Railroad Commission of Texas in April of 2024. He is employed part-time as a project manager in the Technical Permitting program. He is also a consultant for the Oklahoma Secretary of Energy and Environment.

Charles came to the Railroad Commission from EPA Region 6 where he was the Water Division Director for just over five years. Prior to that Charles was with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality in Austin, Texas, where he served as Director of the Radioactive Materials Division from 2012-2018, and Director of Water Quality Division from 2009 to 2012. Charles's impressive resume includes experience as a senior executive and manager along with varied experience in environmental programs.
