# **ESA Regulatory Activity**

- ESA section 4 regulations listing, delisting and critical habitat
- ESA section 4(d) regulations -threatened species
- ESA section 7 regulations -- consultation
- ESA section 10 regulations -- permitting





### ESA Regulatory Activity – Section 4

- ESA section 4 regulations (listing and critical habitat)
  - 89 Fed. Reg. 24,300 (April 5, 2024)
  - Reinstate Obama-era approach to designating unoccupied critical habitat
  - Adjust definition of "foreseeable future" for purposes of listing threatened species
- ESA section 4(d) regulations (threatened species)
  - 89 Fed. Reg. 23,919 (April 5, 2024)
  - Return to historical USFWS approach to automatically extending take prohibition to threatened species unless species-specific rule dictates otherwise

#### ESA Regulatory Activity – Section 7

- ESA section 7 regulations (consultation)
  - 89 Fed. Reg. 24,268 (April 5, 2024)
  - Establish USFWS has authority to require offsets as a reasonable and prudent measure
  - Update definition of "environmental baseline" for jeopardy purposes
  - Update definition of "effects of the action"

#### ESA Regulatory Activity – Section 10

- ESA section 10 regulations
  - 89 Fed. Reg. 26,070 (April 12, 2024)
  - Consolidate Candidate Conservation Agreement with Assurances and Safe Harbor Agreements into a "Conservation Benefit Agreement"
  - Incorporate Five-Point Policy concepts into regulations directly (e.g. monitoring should be commensurate with impacts of the take)
  - Continue position that non-listed species can be covered by HCP without lead species
  - Continue position discouraging use of CBAs by energy industry sector

- Dunes sagebrush lizard

- Allegheny Wood Product, Inc. v. U.S. Fish and Wildlife Serv., 2:22-CV-007, at \*1 (N.D. W.Va. Feb. 12, 2024).
- Golden-cheeked Warbler litigation (ongoing)
- Lesser Prairie Chicken litigation (ongoing)



# **Congressional Activity**

- ESA reform bill expected by Rep. Westerman
- Several other ESA reform bills have been filed but none have moved.
- Several other riders and Congressional Review Act (CRA) resolutions have ben introduced
  - 10 CRA resolutions introduced in 2024 focused on disapproving the ESA regulatory revisions for Section 4, 4(d), and 7.
  - CRA resolutions have been filed disapproving of the listing of Texas mussels and dune sagebrush lizard
- No movement on bills delisting dunes sagebrush lizard and lesser prairie chicken



#### What's next?

- Potential revamp of the Significant Portion of its Range Policy
- Potential proposed Compensatory Mitigation Mechanism Regulations
- Proposed updates to HCP Handbook
- Between Loper, Corner Post, and an election year, plenty of potential for litigation, rollbacks, or legislative changes
