**RE:** Summer 2025 Agency Law Student Internships through the State Bar of Texas Environmental and Natural Resources Law Section

The purpose of this memorandum is to inform you of the State Bar of Texas - Environmental & Natural Resources Law Section's sponsorship of eight (8) summer internships for students currently in their **second year** of law school with each of the following:

- (i) Texas Commission on Environmental Quality - Austin;
- (ii) Office of the Attorney General (Environmental Protection Division) - Austin;
- (iii) Railroad Commission of Texas - Austin;
- (iv) Texas Parks and Wildlife Department - Austin;
- (v) Texas Water Development Board - Austin;
- (vi) City of Dallas (Office of Environmental Quality and Sustainability) – Dallas;
- (vii) Harris County District Attorney's Office (Environmental Crimes Section) - Houston; and
- (viii) Environmental Protection Agency Region 6 Office - Dallas

The objective of the Section's internship program is to provide eight (8) law students who have demonstrated an interest in environmental law with an opportunity to obtain practical experience through one of the sponsored internships. The internships will last six (6) weeks during either half of the summer of 2025. Each of the eight (8) students selected will receive a **\$5,500** stipend from the Section as a reward for his or her selection.

To be eligible for selection for one of the internships, students must submit all of the following: (1) the completed application form; (2) an unofficial copy of the student's most current transcript; and (3) the student's updated resume. All three of the above-mentioned documents are required to be submitted for an applicant to be considered.
